Databases AutoCAD supports three types of databases for storing drawing information: DXF, DWG and DGN. There are currently two versions of AutoCAD for databases:

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DWG-2003 and DWG-2007. DWG-2003 and DWG-2007 are compatible with each other, and so a DWG-2007 file is compatible with AutoCAD. DWG-2003 can read and write DXF, DGN and DWG files. AutoCAD DWG-2007 can read and write DXF, DGN, DWG, DGN-3, and DWF. AutoCAD DesignCenter is a desktop application that creates, edits, and manages drawings for AutoCAD. DBX is a proprietary file format introduced by Autodesk in 2002. Drawing Histograms When creating a dimension, you can add a designator to the side of the dimension line or a text box on the annotation. By default, the number of vertical and horizontal lines is shown in an outline box. The height of the box indicates the number of added lines, and the width indicates the number of added columns. Now you can configure the box so that you can see the actual value. For example, if you want to

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know how many columns there are in the dimension, you can just count the added lines, divide by the column spacing, and multiply by the designator width.
