History AutoCAD was initially developed by John Walker at the University of California, San Diego in 1982. A designer with extensive experience in computer graphics programs and an interest

in programming, Walker found it impossible to communicate the principles of a design program to a workgroup and was discouraged from further work in the field.

The 1986 release of AutoCAD R14.0, which included a first version of the 2D drafting application, marked the first time that a computer-

aided drafting (CAD) program was released as a desktop application. Although the current version of AutoCAD, AutoCAD LT 2017, is available as both a desktop and web application, the desktop version remained the primary application until 2016. In 2002, AutoCAD was moved to the Autodesk Portfolio

Services business unit and the company has continued to release major new versions every three years. The first AutoCAD LT was released in 2004.

The latest version is AutoCAD LT 2017. In 2017, it was announced that AutoCAD LT would be discontinued on July 20th, 2017, and that it would be replaced with

AutoCAD Architecture.
One-time use licenses One-time use licenses (OTULs) are offered in the \$995USD category. OTULs do not expire and are typically purchased to be used for 3 or 5 years, although this time period may vary. Standard license Standard licenses are available in the \$2,995USD category.

These licenses do expire and are typically purchased for 3 to 5 years, although this time period may vary. To access the new AutoCAD 2017 applications, the AutoCAD 2016 LT application has been removed from the program. Users that are currently using this product will need to

uninstall it before they can install the 2017 version. This is the first time that the standard version of AutoCAD has been discontinued. The current standard license allows users to register multiple users. The standard version of AutoCAD comes with a number of industry-standard visual aids, including:

may purchase a longer license). After that time, the software is inactive until the subscription is renewed. On January 1, 2015, Autodesk began offering an annual subscription for AutoCAD, which offers additional features including a cloud-based integrated drawing storage space, cloud versioning

and universal design. The subscription is to be paid in advance for one year, with monthly pricing of approximately US\$7 per month. For those on annual subscription, the cloud-based storage capacity allows users to save drawings anywhere in the world. AutoCAD 2018 also added support for cloud versioning to

AutoCAD, which stores future versions of drawings in the cloud for 30 days before switching to the older version.

AutoCAD for small business AutoCAD software for small business is available in a number of editions. The majority of AutoCAD for small business is available on a per-user, or per-

employee, basis. There are options for multi-user or enterprise license.

Enterprise licenses are priced based on the number of users and the features needed, including but not limited to drawing storage, sharing and collaborative features.

User Types AutoCAD has three types of users:

Subscribers: users pay a

one-time license fee for a certain number of users. Subscribers may use the software on up to two computers. Customized Users: users purchase a license and then may customize and use the software on up to three computers. Subscription Users: users purchase a subscription to AutoCAD with an annual

subscription fee. The subscription fee includes a number of users.

Subscription users may use the software on up to three computers. A typical subscription fee is US\$7.50 per month.

Subscription users have the same features as Customized Users, and can customize their product as they wish. AutoCAD also

has a Sales and Service Agreement, which requires users to contact AutoCAD to obtain service, support and upgrades from AutoCAD. AutoCAD provides one telephone and online support and online service updates. Licensing AutoCAD for small business is priced based on the number of users. There
